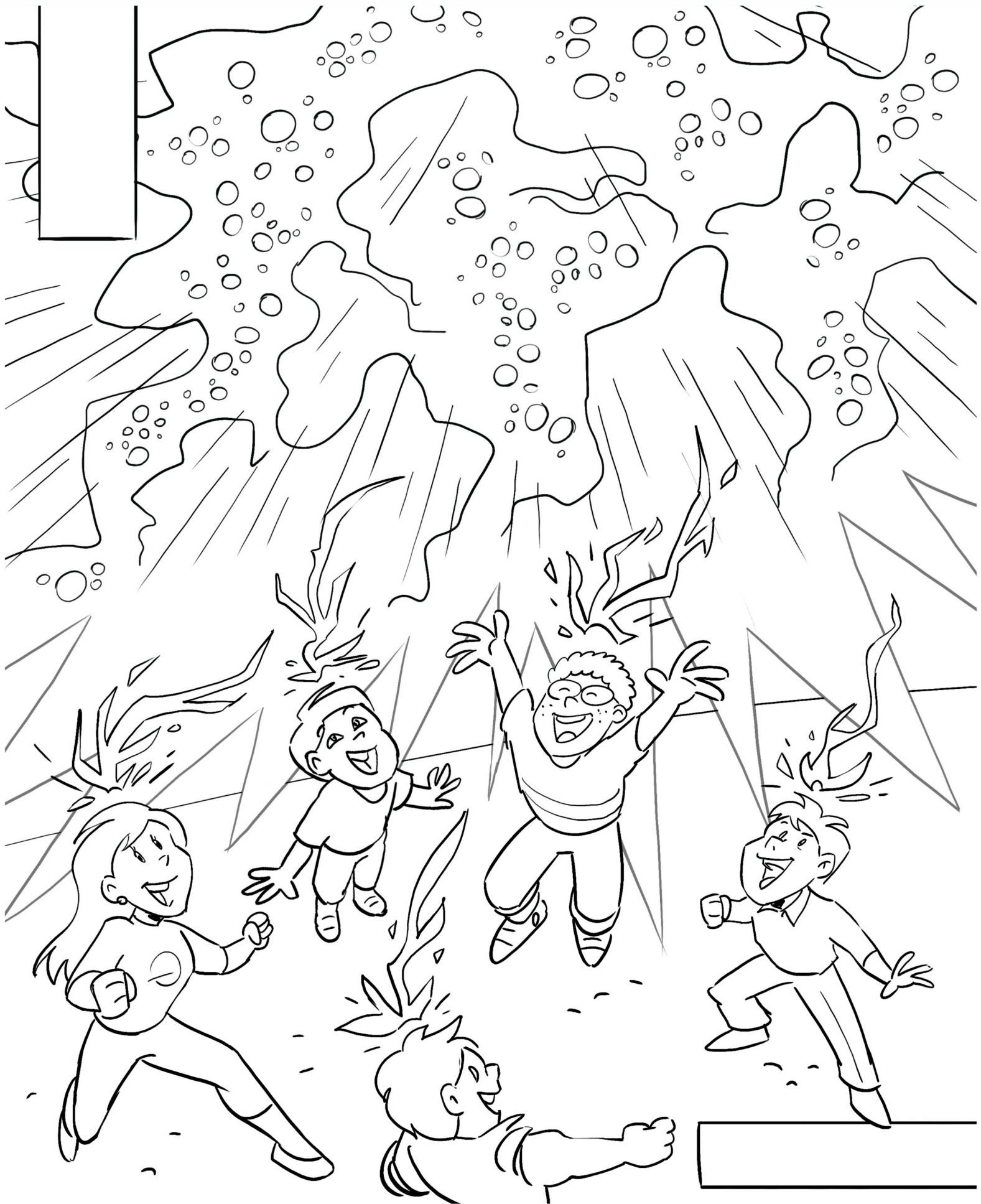

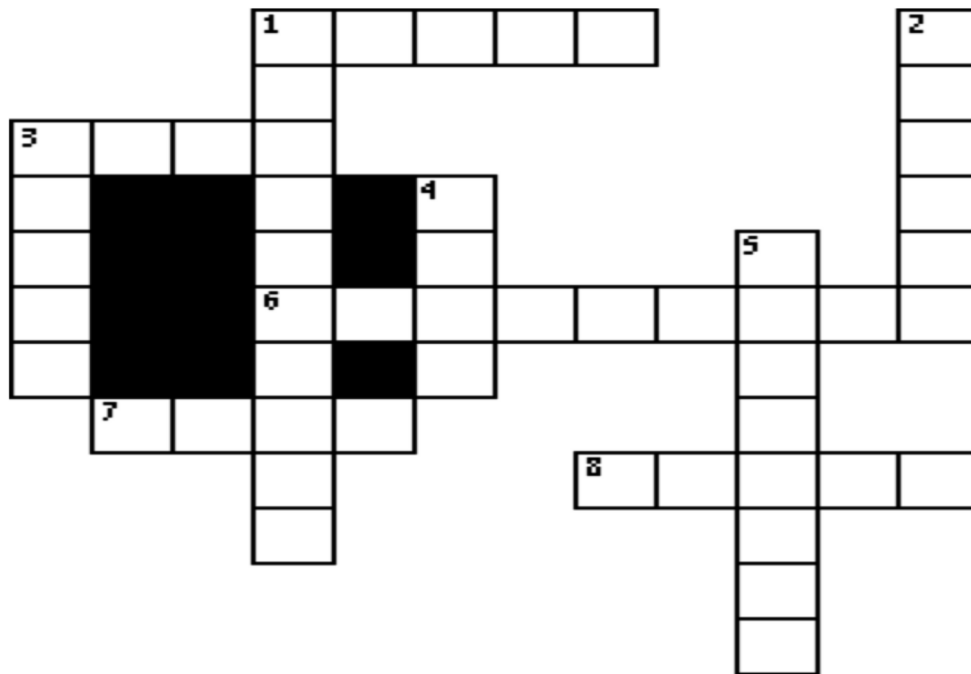

THE HOLY SPIRIT COMES

Acts 2:1-13

CRAFT/ACTIVITY: HEADBANDS

Students will make a “tongue of fire” headband to help remind them that the Holy Spirit came on the day of Pentecost.

MATERIALS

1. 67 lb. Cardstock
2. Tongue of Fire Headband Pattern
3. Crayons, Markers, or Colored Pencils
4. Tape
5. Scissors



DIRECTIONS

1. Make copies of the “Tongue of Fire Headband Pattern” for each student onto 67 lb. cardstock.
2. Have students color the “tongue of fire” with crayons, markers, or colored pencils.
3. Allow students to cut out the “tongue of fire” and the headbands on the solid black lines.
4. Tape the “tongue of fire” to the headband pieces.
5. Tape the two headband pieces together around each student’s head.

FOR DISCUSSION

As students are working on their headbands, remind them that Jesus promised to send the Holy Spirit when he ascended to Heaven. The Holy Spirit, also called the Counselor, was sent to guide us in all truth. Help students realize that when they ask Jesus into their hearts, the Holy Spirit dwells in them.

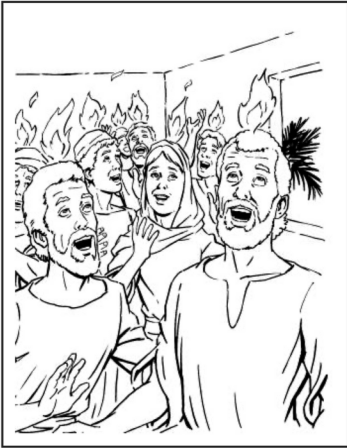

heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw what appeared to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. It was the Holy Spirit that came upon each of the disciples. They began to speak in tongues as the Spirit enabled them.

Other people heard the sound of the Holy Spirit coming upon the disciples and a crowd began to form. The crowd heard the disciples speaking in tongues and some understood what they were saying. Others just made fun of the disciples saying, "They have had too much wine."

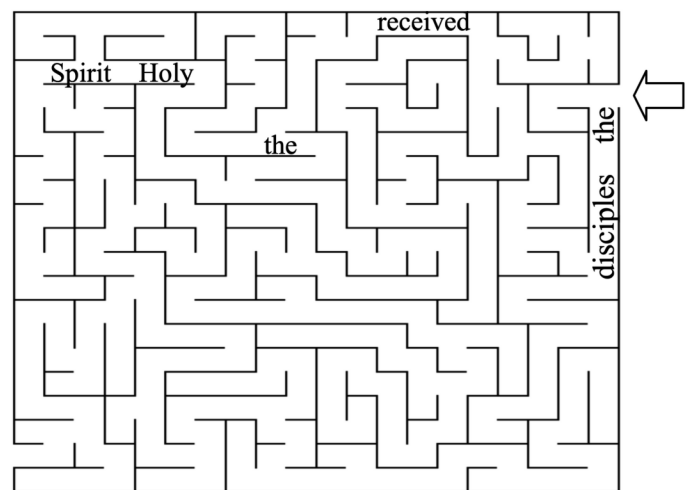

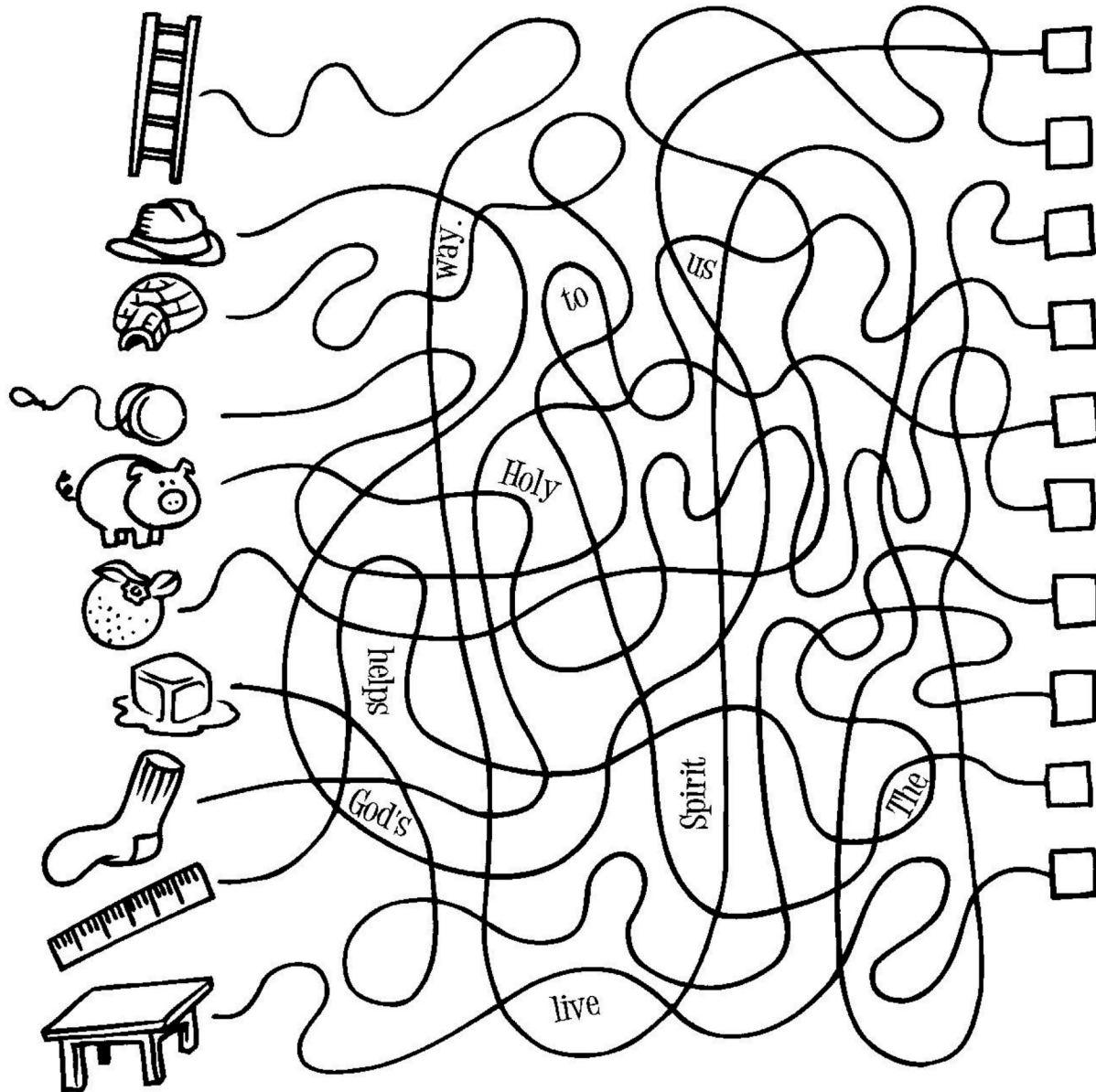
